

Tilia cordata 'Glenleven'

'Glenleven' Linden

Zone: 4-8

Height: 45'

Width: 30'

Crown: Oval, pyramidal

Growth: Fast

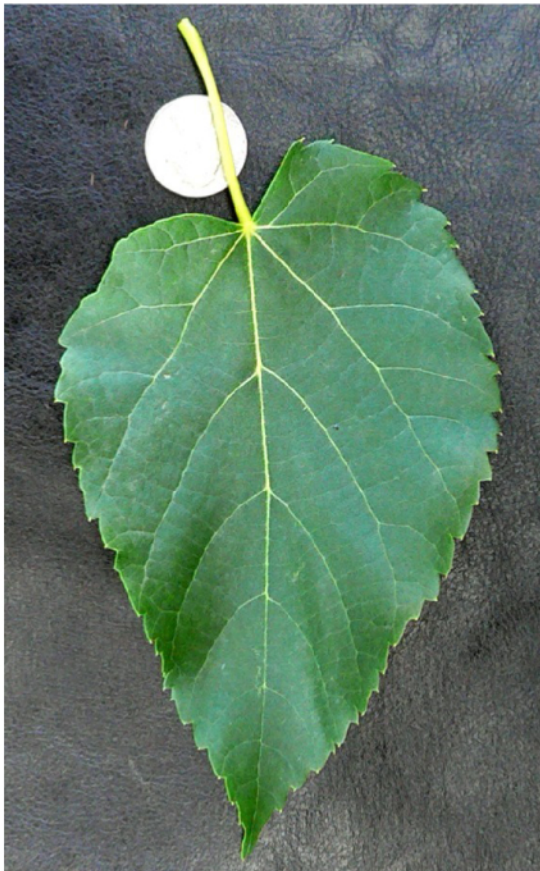
Soil: Clay, loam, sand

pH: Acid or alkaline

Drainage: Well drained

Drought: Moderate

Breakage: Resistant



Tilia is said to be a pyramidal tree, but in our Experience it is more spreading. The branches are horizontal, so there won't have any problems with the crotches. They are difficult to ship after the canopy gets larger. Otherwise, this is a fine tree. It is more vigorous than the other *T. cordata* cultivars. It has the sweetest fragrance when in bloom and is all abuzz with bees. Don't bother them and they won't bother you. This is a fairly open tree with age, but it is very densely leafed and gives a deep shade. Be sure your trees have a single leader, and allow plenty of space between scaffolding branches, because they will become huge.
