

## Prunus serrulata 'Kwanzan

## 'Kwanzan' Ornamental Cherry

Zone: 5-8

Height: 30'

Crown: Vase, upright  
Growth: Moderate  
Soil: Loam, sand

Drainage: Well drained

Breakage: Resistant



Prunus 'Kwanzan' is probably the most used cherry on the market with good reason. Nothing gives a more stunning foliar display. The tree is covered each spring with bold clusters of double bright pink flowers. They last for two weeks, then fall from the tree, imitating pink snow. They may cover the walkways under the tree for a day, still pink.

There is seldom fruit on this tree. All cherries should be planted in full sun and loamy or sandy soil which is well drained.
