Ginkgo biloba 'Autumn Gold'

'Autumn Gold' Maidenhair Tree

Zone: 4-8

Height: 50'

Width: 30'

Crown: Symmetrical, oval

Growth Rate: Slow

Soil: Clay, loam, sand

pH: Acid, alkaline

Drainage: Well drained, some wet

Drought: High tolerance

Salt: Poor tolerance

Breakage: Resistant

Pests: Few if any



The plant to the left is not an 'Autumn Gold'. This photo shows how majestic a large specimen of Ginkgo biloba can be. 'Autumn Gold' is not as wild as this seedling Ginkgo. Once found only in the fossil record, a small forest was discovered in China. Since then it has spread and become well loved. The clean, unusual leaves of this deciduous conifer are eye catching. The drought tolerance and lack of diseases have made it a very successful tree. It also takes urban conditions like compacted soil and pollution in stride. 'Autumn Gold' is a male cultivar chosen for its form, wind resistance and its excellent golden fall color.
