Pin Oak is very strongly upright as a young tree. Its form at 6" caliper will be strongly pyramidal. It is with age that Pin Oak rounds out. There seem to be no diseases or insects that Pin Oak is susceptible to. Once established, Pin Oak can be very vigorous. While there seems to be little problems growing Pin Oak, care should be taken when placing this tree.
